## **Student Supply List**

Please bring as much of the following as you can.

Note book/pen/pencil

2 or more Turkey baster(s) (Dollar store)

Assorted empty plastic containers 3 or 4 (margarine, larger yogurt, ice cream)

Handi wipes, 2 packages or old towels or wool blankets that can be cut

1 or 2 Sponges, like those used for cleaning - size comfortable for your hand

Masking tape and permanent marker (sharpie)

Papers to recycle – best resources for your recycling efforts – used envelopes, (with any plastic windows removed) scrap card stock in colors, (preferably not children's construction papers scraps, these are not strong & colors fade)

*The better the paper scraps the better the paper pulp you will make. High % cotton or linen is best. The color of the paper scraps will determine color of the paper pulp.*

Old cookie sheet/bar pan or similar base board for transporting damp papers home.

Rubber or plastic apron or a large garbage bag - useful to wear over clothing

Safety Glasses/Goggles Rubber Gloves (kitchen variety) to fit your hands

Cooked fibers will be prepared ahead for the first day and we will discuss additional options you may bring to the second class.

Optional or as desired for drying at home:

- 10-15 blotters and cardboard
- Old newspapers not the colorful slick advertising pages as they are non-absorbent.
