-**picture frame**, greeting card sized, with glass and back intact. We can add hanging hardware in class if necessary. Please don't buy a new one- used picture frames can be found at almost any thrift store- check out the St. Vincent De Paul stores in Madison or Verona. I'll also have a few extra picture frames available for purchase.

- Bring your own **small bits of jewelry, natural objects, coins, broken glass, watches, beads**- basically any meaningful life-detritus that you want to incorporate into your piece. Its o.k. if you only have a few items- there will also be a big tray of misc components for everyone to use.

*optional- Bring **a simple outline or image that's meaningful or pleasing to you**, to serve as your overall mosaic shape. It must be recognizable as a silhouette, and fit comfortably inside the frame you chose. I'll have some natural shapes on hand as well...

Please bring the following if you have them; if not, we'll have some available to lend...

-**tweezers or forceps, and needle-nose pliers**

-**Glass nippers or glass cutters, garden gloves, protective eye-ware, and an old hand towel** if you plan to use glass in your piece
