Additional types and colors of ink, acrylics, brushes, handouts

Student Supplies to bring:

Calligraphy pen and nib

Pen Holder (if you have a set, bring that.)

Nibs or Tips C-0, and either C-2 or C-3

LC-0 and either LC-2 or LC-3 if left handed

Lined notebook paper, pad or loose (collage ruled = narrower lines is best)

India Ink (1 or 2 oz. size)

Ruler / Pencil /eraser (gum eraser is better)

Small assortment of unlined paper; printer paper, or cardstock. Better papers to be discussed and purchased on an individual basis as desired for finished works, for this you may wish to wait until after the class.
